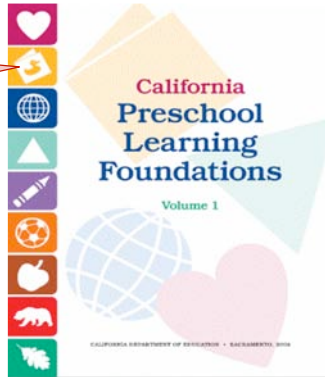



- How can you explain the similarities and differences?


